Career Day is the Ca' Foscari University Job Fair where companies can collect *Curricula* (CVs) and meet 'Cafoscarins and Cafoscarines' – the University's Alumni – spanning all Fields of Study.

WHO

HOW

For the Organization of the Online Career Day, the Career Service Office employs the M.I.T.O. Platform provided by the AlmaLaurea Consortium.

In addition to this, Ca' Foscari's Career Day features:

- **The Company Profile** in the event's **e-book**, published prior to the weeks leading up to Career Day.
- **An Online Company Booth** on the M.I.T.O. Web Platform, **tailored and custom-made to** each Company: featuring the company's Logo, an 'About Us' Section, Open Position information, and Profiles sought.
- **Applications Collection and a Scheduled Interviews Agenda:** Career Day is a **Pre-selection** and **By Invitation Only Event**. Students must submit their Applications at the Company's booth, and the Company selects whom to meet at the event.
- **Online Career Day/Live Day:** The Company interviews the prospective Applicants and students on this day.

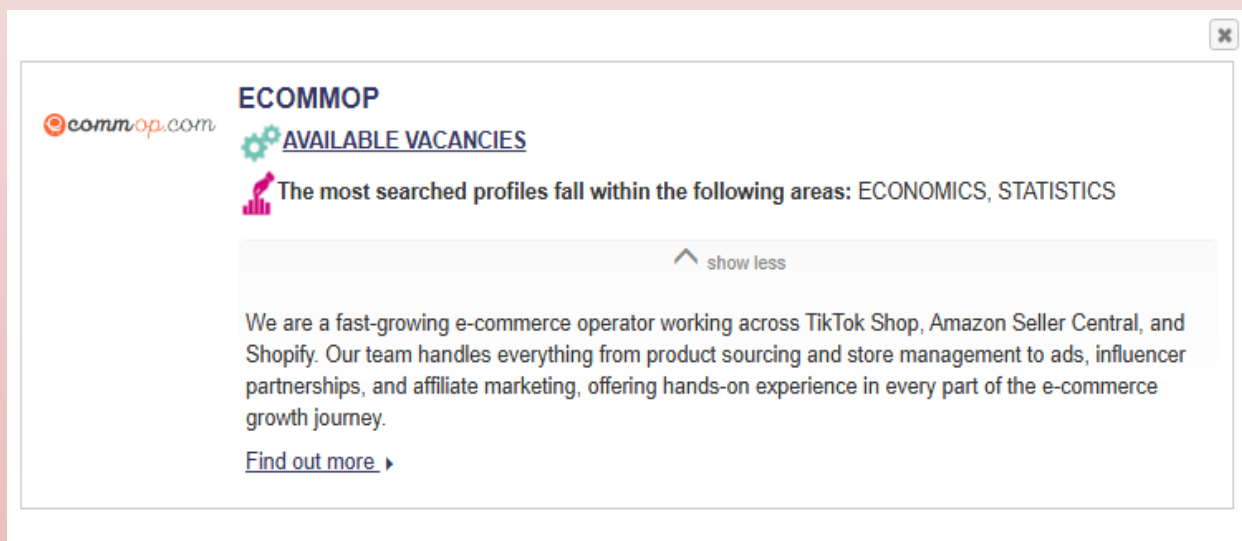

Online Booth

Cafoscarins and Cafoscarines can visit the online booth of any company or business in the weeks preceding the event, thus getting to know the company through the 'Who We Are', 'Available Vacancies', and 'Sought Profiles' Sections, and collecting more elements to decide on whether to submit one's own AlmaLaurea CV to the company or business.

AlmaLaurea CV Matching

According to the Professional Figures sought by the Companies, the System processes the Matching.

By Default, each Company examines the List of Applicants by highest matching.

Furthermore, in order to facilitate the process, Applicants reaching the highest matching are identified with a green band signage.

M.I.T.O. is an AlmaLaurea Consortium, therefore the actual Matching is processed according to the standards of the AlmaLaurea CV.

Online Career Day: Interviews on Web Platform

During the Online Career Day, the Online Interviews take place on the actual Web Platform.

This enables Recruiters as well as Applicants to operate in line with the Career Day atmosphere and spirit.

AGREEMENT

By and Between the following Parties:

Fondazione Università Ca' Foscari Venezia with General Headquarters in Venice, Dorsoduro n. 3246, and Executive Hheadquarters in Dorsoduro 3859/A, Social Security Number and VAT Number 03387580271, represented by: General Director, Dott.ssa Cristiana Rita Alfonsi, born in Rome on 15/03/1959 henceforth referred to as "Fondazione Ca' Foscari";

and

_____, hereinafter referred to as the "Customer";

Whereas:

- a) By virtue of this agreement (hereinafter the "Agreement"), Fondazione Università Ca' Foscari, an instrumental *corpus* of Ca' Foscari University of Venice, promotes and manages services supplementary and subsidiary to the activities of the University. It also promotes and manages orientation support services and internship activities for students in selecting their study plans, support services for the improvement of study conditions and the integration of graduates into the professional/job market, and organizes seminars, conferences, conventions, exhibitions and other cultural events, also in collaboration with other public or private subjects;
- b) On the basis of the Agreement existing between Fondazione Ca' Foscari and the Career Service Office of Venice's Ca' Foscari University, in collaboration with that Office, Fondazione Ca' Foscari encourages and promotes interaction initiatives with the professional/job market of;
- c) The Customer is interested in developing opportunities for interaction between the company and students, undergraduates, and graduates;
- d) The Customer has identified the opportunity for such interaction to take place through direct contact with the Career Service Office of Ca' Foscari University of Venice, via the Fondazione Ca' Foscari.

Now Therefore:

1. Scope

The Subscription Form, as completed and executed by the Customer, constitutes the Object of this Agreement.

2. Methods of carrying out the Service, and Duration

Fondazione Ca' Foscari acknowledges **Dr. Arianna Cattarin** as the person in charge of the organization and taking place of the Events, who may use External Collaborators for the Development of the Project. The Customer may directly liaise with the Collaborators, as appointed by Fondazione Ca' Foscari.

The Assignment is conferred from the Execution Date of this Agreement until the day following the specific event. Meetings will take place on the dates and at the locations specified in the Subscription Form.

3. Confidentiality

Fondazione Ca' Foscari hereby acknowledges, personally and for its Collaborators, the right of complete confidentiality of any information shared in the course of their work, hereby committing not to communicate any such information to any third parties, or to share it in any way, whether during or after the Termination of the aforesaid Collaboration.

4. Consideration

For the commissioned service, Customer shall pay a Fee corresponding to the sum of the requested and confirmed services in the Subscription Form (amounting to Euro 500.00). The amount must be paid in advance of service use, upon receipt of an invoice issued by Fondazione Ca' Foscari. Failure by Customer to make payment within 60 days of the invoice issuance by Fondazione Ca' Foscari will result in the cancellation and termination of this agreement. 5. Withdrawal and Penalties

The Client may withdraw from this Agreement by notifying Fondazione Ca' Foscari via Registered mail with Receipt Acknowledgment or Certified Email at fondazione.cafoscari@legalmail.it.

Withdrawal will incur penalties as follows:

1. Notification with at least 90 days' notice before the event date: no penalty;
2. Notification with at least 60 days' notice before the event date: penalty amounting to 50% of the fee specified in Article 4;
3. Notification with at least 30 days' notice before the event date: penalty amounting to 70% of the fee specified in Article 4;
4. Notification within 30 days prior to the event date: penalty amounting to 100% of the fee specified in Article 4.

6. Personal Data Collected and Processed Under the Agreement

Each Party shall process the Personal Data necessary for the Execution of this Agreement concerning the representatives, employees, and/or collaborators of the other Party. The Parties acknowledge, pursuant to Article 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679 ("GDPR"), that the Personal Data communicated by them for the conclusion and Execution of this Agreement are collected and processed by the other Party as independent Controllers for such purposes and for related regulatory, administrative, and accounting obligations.

Furthermore, after reviewing the privacy notice available at this link <https://fondazione.unive.it/altri-contenuti/privacy/informativa-newsletter>, Customer expresses an interest in receiving news, communications, and updates regarding future initiatives carried out by the Fondazione. Therefore, Customer authorizes the Fondazione, also on behalf of their Representatives, to use the contact details of the latter collected under this Agreement for the aforementioned purpose. Customer acknowledges that they may object to these communications, even subsequently, by selecting the appropriate link at the bottom of each email or by sending a notification to the Data Protection Officer at the following address: dpo.fondazione.cf@unive.it.

The Parties undertake to inform their personnel about the aforementioned processing, indicating that such personnel are granted the rights of access, rectification, restriction, erasure, portability, and objection (Articles 15–22 of the GDPR), as well as the right to file a complaint with the Data Protection Authority.

7. Responsibilities Under Legislative Decree 231/2001 and the Code of Ethics

Customer declares to be aware of the adoption by the Fondazione of the Organization, Management, and Control Model pursuant to Legislative Decree no. 231 of June 8, 2001, in its latest approved version, as well as the Code of Ethics, which forms an integral part of it. These documents are available on the website <https://www.unive.it/pag/8162/>.

Customer undertakes to act in accordance with the provisions contained therein, to promptly report any violations, including suspected ones, of these documents by using the dedicated email address anticorruzione.fondazione.cafoscari@unive.it, and to verify any updates to the Code of Ethics during the contractual relationship and comply with its principles.

Customer further acknowledges that adherence to these provisions is an essential component of the Fondazione's corporate organization and its willingness to enter into this Agreement.

Failure by Customer to comply with any of the provisions of the Code of Ethics entitles the Fondazione to formally notify Customer in writing, pursuant to Article 1454 of the Italian Civil Code, to fulfill its obligations in accordance with the Code of Ethics. If 15 days pass from the receipt of such notice without any compliance, the Agreement shall be considered terminated.

8. Non-Compliance

In the event of non-compliance by either party with the obligations arising from this agreement, the other party may, without resorting to any judicial procedure, terminate or withdraw from this agreement after issuing a formal notice to comply, sent by registered letter to the counterpart.

Specifically, in the case of non-compliance by Fondazione Ca' Foscari with the obligations assumed under this agreement, Customer shall not be required to pay any amount, and any portion of the fee already paid shall be fully or partially refunded in the case of partial non-compliance.

If the event covered by this agreement cannot take place due to causes beyond the control of the parties, which are recognized by both as proven force majeure events, Customer shall not be required to pay any portion of the agreed fee, and Fondazione Ca' Foscari shall likewise be released from its obligations under this agreement.

9. Registration

If used, pursuant to Art. 5, paragraph 2 of Presidential Decree no. 131 of 22/4/86, this Agreement must be registered by the requesting party.

10. Dispute resolution

All disputes arising from this Agreement will be referred to the mediation service of the Chamber of Arbitration of Venice, at the Chamber of Commerce of Venice, an organization authorized to manage mediation procedures. Should it not prove possible to carry out the mediation attempt or should the mediation not succeed in reaching an agreement, any disputes will be settled by arbitration administered by the Arbitration Chamber of Venice, according to its Rules, which is responsible for appointing the single Arbitrator.

11. Final Provisions

All formal communications between the Parties pursuant to this Agreement shall be sent in writing by registered letter with return receipt to the addresses indicated below, in advance by e-mail or fax, or by certified email, to the addresses and numbers that the Parties shall promptly communicate to each other. This Agreement supersedes any previous understanding, agreement or arrangement between the Parties on the subject.

Any amendments to this Agreement shall be made in writing and signed by the duly authorized representatives of both Parties.

Any annulment and/or invalidation of one or more clauses of this Agreement shall not result in the annulment and/or invalidation of the entire Agreement if it can still be executed in the absence of such annulled and/or invalidated clauses.

The failure of a Party to require, at any time, any provision of this Agreement be fulfilled, shall not be construed as a waiver of such provision, nor shall it have any effect on the overall or partial validity of this Agreement, nor the right of the Parties to require that any provision of this Agreement be fulfilled. No waiver of any breach of this Agreement shall constitute a waiver of any subsequent breach.

The Parties represent and warrant that all the clauses of this Agreement have been subject to specific negotiation and approval, therefore Articles 1341 and 1342 of the Italian Civil Code do not apply.
